



RESPONSIBLE RE-ENTRY LEARNERS AND OBSERVERS TIMELINE
PROPOSAL - Updated 8.27.2020; Updated 9.1.2020

June 1st: LEARNERS - This was when we first started bringing back 3rd year medical students and other groups of learners, i.e. COP, CON, and CAHS. We continued to stagger other groups throughout this month. (UCH Department of Educational Placements)

July 6th: LEARNERS - The second group of medical students entered the clinic, so both classes of M3/M4 will be back in the health system. Continuing to bring students back into the ambulatory setting for these clinical rotations. (UCH Department of Educational Placements)

July 20th: MA EXTERNS and HR Job Shadowing (Medical Assistants) - Job Shadowing for observers in the system, for hiring needs with *technical skills*. Please see attached attestation and checklist that will be managed by Human Resources and UCH Department of Educational Placements.

September 8th: Limited OBSERVERS – An individual in a required course, with an observation component, can return to the system with additional restrictions; checklist and attestation from above. We will allow individuals who are 18 years and older at this time. Managed UCH Department of Educational Placements for approval.

October 5th: OBSERVERS + INTERVIEWS – Starting to allow observers back to the system. Managed by UCH Department of Educational Placements for approval. Face-to-face interview and/or pre-offer job shadowing will also occur at this time; approved and managed by Human Resources.

TBD – Participating High Schools (observers 16-18 years old)

November 2nd – 13th: GREATER CINCINNATI, NORTHERN KENTUCKY MILITARY SMART PROGRAM through the Health Collaborative
